

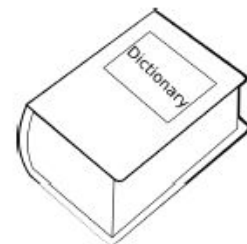


Summer Reading Assignment for Incoming 5th Grade Students
